

### **GENERAL ENGLISH COURSES** (Group size: maximum 10)



The General English course **(Standard 15 hours)** at LanguageUK is aimed at students who want to be able to communicate effectively with English speakers and who need to understand the written and spoken word. The 4 skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking are at the heart of the course, with great emphasis also being placed on grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation.

There are two summer General English courses: **Standard General English** – 15 hours per week **Intensive General English** – 23 hours per week

INTENSIVE ENGLISH AFTERNOON OPTIONS			
<b>General English Extension – Class topics negotiated</b>	IELTS Preparation		
During the afternoon students can choose to join a general English class and focus on a chosen topic or skills area that they feel they need to practise further. On the first Monday of every week students are given the opportunity to negotiate in English and as a group what they would like to study or focus on during the afternoons. It might be a skills area such as speaking or pronunciation . Students might want to focus on skills for work such as emailing or cross cultural communications possibly they would like to their experience of living in the UK and to the language needed in "real life". The weekly plan for the afternoon class will depend on the students attending and what they would like to practise. ### **INTENSIVE IELTS PREPARATION** 23 hours (Group size: maximum 10 students)

**The IELTS Intensive** preparation course at LanguageUK is designed to improve your scores in all parts of the test. Your teacher will help you with exam techniques and Academic English for maximising your score. Particular attention will be paid to improving your skills in writing and reading as we understand that these components can be the most challenging at this level. Throughout this course you will also be given the opportunity to take IELTS Practice tests which will help you and your teacher monitor your progress. You will also be given the option to take the IELTS exam in the UK at the end of the course. We recommend this course for students who have reached a B1+ level of English

### INTENSIVE IELTS PREPARATION Suitable to level B1 plus

### **Designed for**

The IELTS preparation course is ideal for students- ranging in ability from Intermediate (B1) to Advanced (C1)- who need to achieve a a band grade level 5 to 7.5 to :

- start a degree or masters programme at a university in the UK or an English-taught degree course abroad.
- work in professional fields such as the medical profession and need to have the IELTS in order to apply for work.

### Classes

During the course we will focus on the exam components that you need help with and this could include:

- Essential exam strategies and techniques for each component in the IELTS exam
- Speed reading techniques and learning how to
- Learn to develop autonomy
- Carry out structured exam practice
- Writing skills required in formal and academic contexts
- Listening comprehension and take notes
- Speed reading and reading comprehension
- Speaking skill in both general and formal context

### GENERAL ENGLISH WITH FORMATIVE BUSINESS TRAINING AND WORK EXPERIENCE 10 week course(30 hours Intensive)

An Intensive course combined with General English and Formative Business Training leading to four final weeks of Work Experience and assignments. The course is a fantastic opportunity for undergraduates, post-graduates or young people who might be looking for work or further study in the future. The combination of General English, Formative Business training and Work Experience could be very useful. This combined with the experience of living abroad would make the perfect "mini gap" period.

#### **Designed for**

School leavers 18 years plus, Undergraduates, post graduates and young professionals starting out on their careers.

#### **Course overview**

Students attend a General English class for 10 weeks in the mornings to improve their English level. During the afternoons for the first 6 weeks the students will study 6 modules of Formative Business topics which aim to give students:

- An excellent platform of knowledge.
- A toolbox of credible skills to start university, work or training in the future.
- An insight into life, language and procedures in the professional world.

During the final four weeks of the course students will work alongside professionals at LanguageUK to develop and complete their projects and assignments. Students will gain invaluable experience.

#### **Course overview**

#### **Needs Analysis**

### **Morning Class**

During the mornings students will attend a class. On the first Monday you will be invited to negotiate practise from a task bank of themes and ideas given to you by your teacher. You are also welcome to bring along your own ideas. Each morning is carefully planned by you teacher whose aims are to encourage "natural" speaking. Some guided practice and attention to linguistic improvement in areas such as grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary will be given on a daily basis. Students will be given a reflection journal and invited to record their daily practice and thoughts.

### Afternoon Trips and activities

For three afternoons a week you will take part in a selection of activities and trips and this is an extension of your class. Your teacher or activity guide will accompany you and encourage you to engage in conversation with the group.
