Family English Courses

50 Plus English & Culture Course

Join us on one of our 50+ English courses . A great way to spend a week or two practising your English. 15 classroom hours, plus 3 afternoon activities and one day trip at the weekend.



Our 50 Plus course is for busy professionals or students who are 50 years and over and who would like to spend a short period of up to one or two weeks practising their English in small groups of up to 8 students maximum. The focus of the course is principally on speaking and vocabulary expansion and is especially designed for students with life experience and who are looking for a course with a difference. Our course includes a selection of “talking trips”, interesting class topics and activities in an environment designed to promote fluency and confidence in the English language.

Teacher Training and Development

Tailored Teacher Development / CLIL Courses funded through Erasmus+ .



LanguageUK offers Teacher Development courses for professionals who teach English or another subject in English. This course is designed for teachers of primary, secondary or university education, with an English level of B1/Intermediate or above.

These CLIL programmes – Content and Language Integrated Learning – are often funded through Erasmus +, and can be taken in a ‘closed’ or international group, depending on requirements.

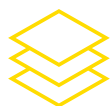

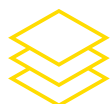

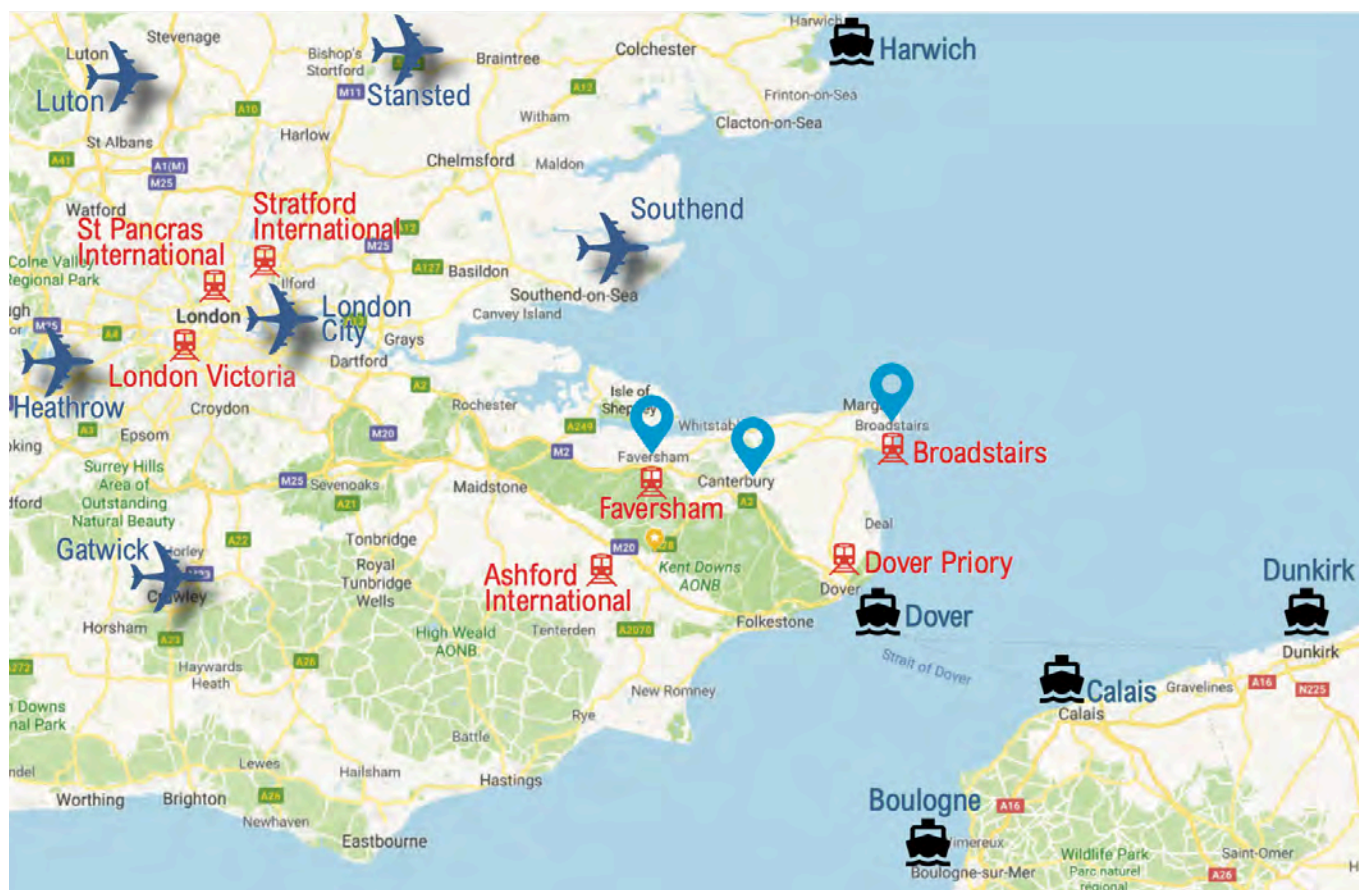
Train

LanguageUK sites are served by the same train lines out of London. You can catch the train to Canterbury or Faversham from St Pancras International or Stratford International, on the Southeastern Hi-Speed service, or from London Victoria.



Ferry

Being on the east Kent coast, we're close to the port of Dover, which means you can get to us easily from continental Europe. If you're driving, you can reach us by following signs to Canterbury. Alternatively, if you're on foot and feeling adventurous, you could walk to Dover Priory station – around 20 minutes from the port and get the train.



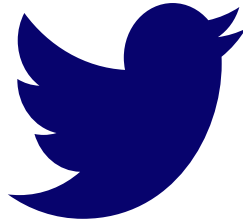
Even better, if you need us to, we can book you a taxi from Dover, London, from any train station or airport. Just give us a call to discuss your travel arrangements.
